Assumption of the Risk and Waiver of Liability Relating to Coronavirus/COVID-19

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. **COVID-19 is extremely contagious** and has significant person-to-person spread. As a result, federal, state, and local governments and federal and state health agencies have recommended social distancing measures and have, in many locations, required ongoing prohibitions on the congregation of groups of people of various sizes.

Boys & Girls Clubs of Border Towns has put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19. These include, but are not limited to, social distancing, wellness monitoring, increased sterilization, required hand-washing, etc.. However, the Club **cannot guarantee** that you or your child(ren) will not become infected with COVID-19. Further, attending the Club **could increase** your risk and your child(ren)'s risk of contracting COVID-19.

By signing this agreement, I acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume the risk that my child(ren) and I may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 by attending the Club and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and death. I understand that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 at the Club may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself and others, including, but not limited to, Club employees, volunteers, and program participants and their families.

I voluntarily agree to assume all of the foregoing risks and accept sole responsibility for any injury to my child(ren) or myself (including, but not limited to, personal injury, disability, and death), illness, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense, of any kind, that I or my child(ren) may experience or incur in connection with my child(ren)'s attendance at the Club or participation in Club programming ("Claims"). Youth Disciplinary Policy

Revised 6-7-2010

1. The Youth Staff will give a verbal warning for any inappropriate behavior or language. We follow a **3 strike policy**. The strikes will result in the disciplinary actions below. However, the **3 strike policy** will not be in effect if any child willfully injures another child, or commits any acts of violence, or is involved with drugs or alcohol.

2. The First offense will result in a minimum of a one-day suspension from youth activities. A written explanation of the incident will be sent through the mail or hand delivered to the

parents or guardian.

3. The Second offense will result in a mandatory week suspension from youth activities. A written explanation of the incident will be sent through the mail or hand delivered to the parents or guardian.

4. The Third offense will result in a suspension based on the Youth Departments discretion.

5. Youth may never leave activities without written or verbal permission from parents or guardian

6. When being transported, seatbelts must be worn as per the state law.

7. If your child is home sick or leaves school sick, he or she will not be allowed to attend Youth Activities for that day.

8. All youth are expected to cooperate, listen and respect youth staff. Any issues will result in a disciplinary write-up.
