ROLE: The role of the Wolastoq Inn and Suites (Stardust Motel) is responsible for the general day-to-day operations of the property and supervising staff of the motel. They will provide exceptional customer service, and ensure a safe and clean environment.

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES:

2. Responding to guest questions and concerns in a timely manner.
3. Provide exceptional customer service.
4. Ability to be on call 7 days a week.
5. Capable of working nights and weekends.
6. Supervise all of the day-to-day activities that take place at the Stardust.
7. Ability to train and manage employees.
8. Employee scheduling and payroll processing.
9. Basic accounting and record keeping.
10. Ability to work and communicate with the general public.
11. Responsible for all of the maintenance scheduling.
12. Ability to be creative and communicate ideas.
13. Ability to communicate and work with the HBMI Tribal Council, Economic Development Director, and HBMI Tribal Community.
14. Ability to work under pressure and on a timely schedule.
15. Competent in conflict resolution.
16. Daily, Weekly and monthly accounting and inventory control processing.
17. Acquisition and retention of all permitting, licensing and certifications to operate.
 - a. Sprinkler System Inspections (Quarterly)
 - b. Emergency Lighting and Extinguisher Inspections (Monthly)
 - c. Any and All permits required but not specifically listed
18. Sales and marketing of facilities.
19. All other duties as deemed necessary by Director.
