ROLE: Under the supervision of the Maintenance Supervisor, this position will assist in performing general maintenance and repairs to the Tribal Administration facilities, grounds, equipment, and vehicles.

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 3. Salting and sanding on an as needed basis.
