Job Title: Food Distribution Warehouse & Delivery Worker

Summary: Under the supervision of the Food Distribution Program Director, will efficiently and effectively implement and monitor the USDA Food Distribution Program, following program guidelines. Will be responsible for to assist clients with intake, applications and determinations of eligibility. Will assist with the organization and cleanliness of the Food Distribution Program Center.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Welcome clients at the Food Distribution Program Center and answer questions
- Responsible for intake of clients and assist in determining their needs
- Develop and maintain applicable forms for various programs and keep forms updated
- Assist clients in completing applications and placing orders
- Process commodities and pack, fill and deliver food orders as appropriate
- Document filled orders, report changes, adjustments or substitutions to the appropriate personnel
- Assist with completing and verifying inventory
- Sorts and stores perishable goods in refrigerated rooms and maintains a log of cooler temperatures and report any deficiencies
- Opens bales, crates and other containers and move to appropriate areas
- Assists in the maintenance of the warehouse while complying with the Food and Safety Standards
- Attend training as appropriate and requested for certification, safe distribution, handling and storage of food
- Maintain client confidentiality
- Function as part of the department team by covering office duties as requested
- Other duties as assigned

Education and Experience

Must have a high school diploma or G.E.D. Experience with operating a fork lift and warehouse equipment.
