Romanelli has more than combined 20 years of experience working for the federal government/federally qualified health care center, bringing a background in care coordination and case management rooted in collaboration, advocacy and respect for tribal governance and ICWA principles. Tompkins most recently worked for the tribe as a warehouse lead delivery driver in the Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR).


